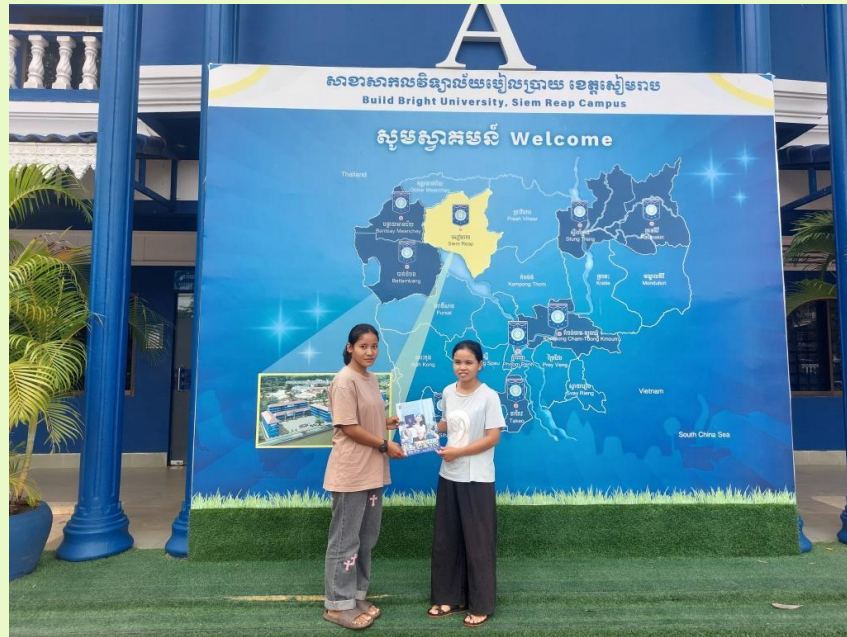


\*\*\* STEP TOWARDS UNIVERSITY \*\*\*

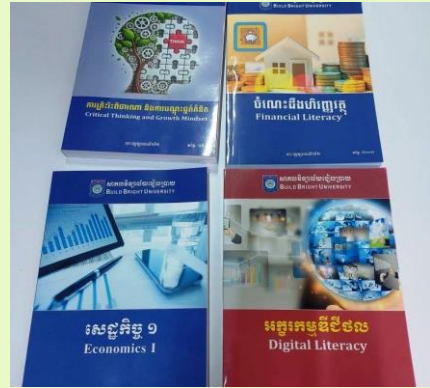

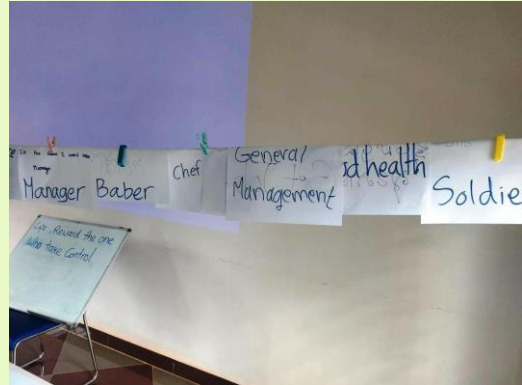

**\*\*\* DOMESTIC VIOLENCE \*\*\***

**Mission in the Chickren district. A 10-year-old boy. STOP CHILD ABUSE!.**



We carried out a very special mission related to DOMESTIC VIOLENCE. Following our complaint from Together for Cambodia (TFC) to KaliyanMith, a branch of Friends International, an organization dedicated to defending children's rights, among other projects, we coordinated a visit with Mr. SITH to the family. Days earlier, we discovered a young child being brutally beaten on the legs by his father, in a village where both parents were exchanging hurtful insults and slaps. Even worse, the younger child, a 10-year-old boy, was also being brutally beaten, regularly.



Many thanks to Friends International and KaliyanMith's emergency child protection hotline **(017.35.87.58)** in Siem Reap. Children who are being abused or who witness child abuse can contact them. They have trained staff ready to respond and take action.

Many thanks to Mr. SITH for his prompt response and for implementing the system to protect the most vulnerable children! Today, TFC readily supported the initiative to interview the parents, the child, and the representative from the local social services department to properly assess the situation, using a standardized methodology and with the highest authority in the community.
